How to Use Selector Chart

- 1. Determine the expected gain for pigs being fed by your 4-H member. Use the past experience you have for that 4-Her and the genetics of the pigs being fed to estimate expected gain. An average figure is 1.7. The chart is based on a minimum of 230 pounds and a maximum of 270 pounds show weight. Use the chart as a guide to estimate minimum and maximum weights of pigs to tag and feed. In recent years there have been far too many very light pigs shown.
- 2. After determining an estimated gain, look at the selection date and the chart will tell you the minimum and maximum weight of selected pigs for that expected gain.
