Possession/Ownership Deadline: February 14, 2021

• To be eligible for the 2021 Knoxville Spring Junior Cattle Expo and State Beef Expo, all market steers must attend one of the below regional tagging days.

Specific times will be provided at a later date.

- Friday, February 12, 2021 evening

- Saturday, February 13, 2021 mid-morning through afternoon
 - Cumberland County Fairgrounds, 34 Music Road, Crossville, TN 38571
- Saturday, February 13, 2021 mid-morning through afternoon
 - o First Farmers Coop, 16219 TN-22, Lexington, TN 38351
- Sunday, February 14, 2021 afternoon
 - Williamson County Ag Expo Park, 4215 Long Lane, Franklin, TN 37064

Tagging Day Procedures

- 840-RFID tag applied
- Tattoo applied (if necessary)
- DNA hair sample collected
- Weighed

Tagging day weight will be used as the starting weight to calculate average daily gain of the market steers. A performance class will be started using the weight at the show as the final weight, or performance will be added to the carcass class (more specific details will be available at a later date).

This tagging day requirement only applies to market steers. Registered Heifers, Commercial Heifers, Prospect Steers (steers weighing less than 900 pounds at the show) and Dairy Feeder Steers will have the same deadline as the 2020 program year.
