¹To be eligible for Farm Bred Division, animal must be produced by a dam solely owned by the exhibitor, his/her parents/legal guardian or his/her grandparents at the time of conception.

Important Date: Ownership/Tagging Deadline: **June 1**. Youth may enter and show up to 8 goats (any combination of Market Goats, Commercial Does and Registered Does). Only 2 commercial does and 2 registered does may be leased. A copy of the lease agreement should accompany the entry form for leased does.
